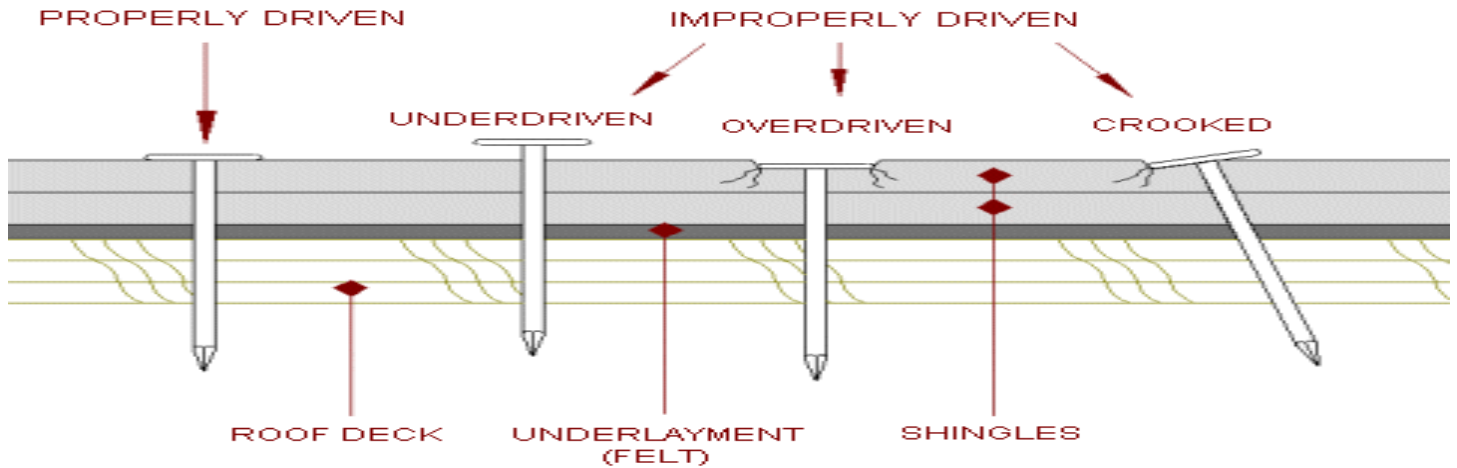


COMMON PROBLEMS WITH NAIL GUNS



UNDERDRIVEN

When nails are under driven they can damage the shingle on top of them leading to leaks.

If someone is hand nailing they would simply tap the nail one more time to set it.



OVERDRIVEN

When nails are over driven they cut through the shingles and cause leaks.

This is a common problem that we face in the roofing business. I see over driven nails several times every week while examining roofs.



CROOKED

Driven crooked a nail can cause problems not only for the shingle it is attached to but to the next course overlaying it as well.

This is a result of being in too big of a hurry to set the nail gun straight and plumb over the shingle when fastening.
